## Authorisation to perform annual survey for lifting appliances and loose gear on ships

### The Swedish Transport Agency's decision (Transportstyrelsens beslut)

The Swedish Transport Agency herewith decides that;

Until further notice, but not longer than the end of 2026, is authorized to perform thorough examination in accordance with instruction 3 of the former Royal Board of Shipping and Navigation in "Register of Ship's Cargo Handling Machinery and Gear", and the regulations for lifting appliances (A9: 1973) with amendments, of the Swedish Maritime Administration.

The authorization is valid under the condition that the initial and the four yearly thorough examinations are performed by a person authorized by the Swedish Transport Agency to issue certificates for lifting appliances and loose gear. The decision is valid until further notice, but may be revoked if any of the above conditions are not met or if the conditions underlying this decision are changed.

### Statement of the matter (Redogörelse för ärendet)

On August 27th 2024 you sent an application for authorization to perform annual survey for lifting appliances and loose gear on ships. Certificate of ISO training for all service personnel was attached to the application.

**Reasons for the decision (Skäl för beslutet)**

C Survey AB, has applied for authorization to perform annual survey for lifting appliances and loose gear on ships. The Swedish Transport Agency has conducted an assessment of the application.

In accordance with the regulations for lifting appliances (A9: 1973) with amendments, the Swedish Transport Agency can decide to authorize individuals and companies to issue certificates and surveys for lifting appliances and loose gear onboard ships.

The Swedish Transport Agency assessment is that the application can be granted.

**How to appeal (Hur man överklagar)**

This decision can be appealed. The appeal shall be in writing, and you shall state which decision you are appealing and what you wish to change. The appeal shall be made to Förvaltningsrätten i Linköping but sent to Transportstyrelsen Sjö och luftfartsavdelningen 601 73 Norrköping. The appeal shall reach the Swedish Transport Agency within 3 weeks after you were informed about this decision.
